



Accessing Moscone Free Wireless

This is a free service provided for attendees. It is available in the following areas: South Upper Lobby, South Lower Lobby, South Concourse, North Concourse, North Lower Lobby, North Upper Lobby, Esplanade Lobby (outside of room 300), West 2nd Floor Lobby, and West 3rd Floor Lobby.

You must open a web browser and register before you will have access to the internet. The registration process does not collect any information and takes only a few seconds. If you do not register, your computer or device will not have access to the internet.

Locate wireless network (SSID) moscone-free-wifi. There are different ways of finding wireless networks on your computer. Here are some possibilities:

Windows Laptops

- 1.) Click "Start", mouse over "Connect To", and click on "Wireless Connection" to open a window which shows all available networks. Remember to look for "moscone-free-wifi".
- 2.) Double click on the "Wireless Connection Icon" on the lower right corner of your screen next to the time. A window with available wireless networks should open. Look for "moscone free-wifi".
- 3.) Use your laptop's proprietary software to look for networks.

Once you have located the wireless network "moscone free-wifi", double click on it to connect or highlight it and click the connect button.

Once you are connected wait about 10-15 seconds to make sure your laptop has received an IP address and open up a web browser (Internet Explorer, Netscape, Firefox, Safari, etc.) and you will be redirected to a Moscone Splash page with a button to connect to the internet. Click the button and you will be redirected to your original URL.

You are now free to surf, email, etc.
